

Dear Prof. Qamar

Kindly find enclosed herewith a copy of minutes of the meeting of Vice-Chancellors of new Central Universities held on 3<sup>rd</sup> March, 2011 in the UGC office for your kind perusal and action if any.

2. In the meeting it was decided that only those academic programmes may be started where the necessary infrastructure facilities/ manpower is available. The proposals in respect of professional courses like Medical, Dental, Nursing, Para-Medical, Engineering & Technology etc. will be considered separately at a later stage. New academic programmes should meet the regional requirements, national aspirations and should be at par with the world class standards. Further, the university should make an assessment of the existing academic programmes as may be available in the adjoining Universities so as to avoid gaps and duplications.

3. Based on the above deliberation, I am directed to convey the approval of UGC to open maximum of 20 departments by the end of XI Plan for which no prior approval of UGC will be required. Accordingly, 140 teaching positions are approved (1 Professor, 2 Associate Professor and 4 Assistant Professors for each department) including the existing programmes which had already been approved by the UGC. After establishing the departments, the university may intimate the status to the UGC.

4. Further, based on the discussions in the meeting as well as the availability of funds from Government of India, MHRD, UGC has approved the Annual Plan Allocation (2011-12) of Rs. 50.00 crores for Central University of Himachal Pradesh under General Development Grant including Merged Scheme and Fellowship to Non-NET Ph.D and M.Phil. The Annual Plan Allocation is tentative and the situation would be reviewed during October – November, 2011.

5. This abovementioned allocation is in addition to the unspent balances as on 1.4.2011 available with the University. University may decide the priorities and provide item wise break-up for General Development Grant (separately for Grant-in-aid General and Capital Assets), Merged Scheme and Fellowships to Non-NET Ph.D. and M.Phil. to UGC within the allocation as mentioned above.

6. It is once again requested that the University may follow the procedure for construction of buildings as circulated vide this office letter number F.17-1/2002 (CU) dated 28<sup>th</sup> April, 2005 (copy enclosed) as well as prescribed in the UGC guidelines for General Development Assistance to Central Universities during XI Plan. The Building Committee should be constituted as per UGC guidelines and information in the prescribed format may be sent to UGC.

Minutes of the Meeting of the Vice Chancellors of the newly established Central Universities (excluding converted Central Universities) held on 3<sup>rd</sup> March, 2011.

A meeting of the Vice Chancellors of the newly established Central Universities (excluding converted Central Universities) was held in the office of the UGC at New Delhi, on 3<sup>rd</sup> March, 2011 from 10.30 a.m. onwards to consider introduction of new academic programmes from the next academic session, annual plan allocations for the year 2011-2012 and also to discuss the progress made by the Universities in terms of infrastructure development, academic programmes launched by the Universities, recruitment of teaching and non-teaching posts etc. The meeting was chaired by the Chairman, UGC. The meeting was attended to by the Vice Chancellors/ representatives of all the newly established Central Universities except the Vice Chancellor, Central University of Orissa. Secretary, UGC, Joint Secretary, MHRD, Joint Secretary (CU), UGC and Deputy Secretary (CU), UGC also attended the meeting. List of participants is at Annexure-I.

The Chairman, UGC, while welcoming the Vice-Chancellors, appreciated the efforts made by each of the Vice-Chancellors, in the development of the respective university, despite facing problems of different kinds like land, faculty recruitment, recruitment of statutory officers etc. He stated that XI Plan thrusts of Higher Education are the expansion, inclusion and promotion of excellence. He informed that at present only 1.51 lakhs students are enrolled in the established Central Universities. He, therefore, requested the Vice Chancellors to take all the measures to increase the students' intake for different courses so as to help in achieving the National target i.e. 15% GER by the end of XI Plan. He also emphasized that the Central Universities should strive to achieve the excellence in teaching and research and set the benchmark for other Higher Education Institutions in the system. The Chairman, UGC assured for full support to honor and ensure the autonomy of the Universities coupled with accountability.

Dr. Renu Batra, Joint Secretary, UGC made a presentation depicting academic programmes started by the newly established Central Universities in 2009-2010 and 2010-11, students' intake & admitted, status of teaching and non-teaching positions, the allocations, release and utilization of funds, ratios of teaching and non-teaching staff as also of teachers and students. Thereafter, she referred to the following issues for discussions in the meeting: -

- (i) Introduction of new Departments/ Academic Programmes;
- (ii) Annual Plan Allocations for the year 2011-2012;
- (iii) Optimal size of academic and physical infrastructure at temporary/ transit campus;
- (iv) Future strategies for introduction of Academic Programmes and Departments from XII Plan onwards;
- (v) Recruitment of non-teaching staff in a phased manner;
- (vi) Norms for outsourcing;
- (vii) Guidelines for construction of buildings – deposit work (100% or partly)

Thereafter, each Vice Chancellor made a detailed presentation on the progress made by them in terms of introduction of academic programmes, development of physical infrastructure, recruitment of teaching & non-teaching staff, status of expenditure etc.

Joint Secretary, MHRD stated that the first Vice-Chancellors have an important role in the development and functioning of the university. The vision of the university set by them will go a long way in the growth of the university. The Vice-Chancellor is the right person to assess the requirements of the university in terms of academic, administrative and financial matters. He also stressed the need for judicious utilization of funds for development of transit/ temporary campus. He assured that the UGC and the MHRD would provide the necessary support in the development of the universities.

In the light of the presentation made by the Vice Chancellors of each of the Central Universities and the discussions held, following decisions were arrived at:

- (i) Each university may establish/ open maximum of 20 departments by the end of XI Plan for which no prior approval of UGC will be required. Accordingly 140 teaching positions are approved (1 Professor, 2 Associate Professor and 4 Assistant Professor for each department) including the existing programmes which had already been approved by the UGC. After establishing the departments, the university may intimate the status to the UGC.
- (ii) Only those academic programmes may be started where the necessary infrastructure facilities/ manpower is available. The proposals in respect of professional courses like Medical, Dental, Nursing Para-Medical, Engineering & Technology etc. will be considered separately at a later stage.
- (iii) New academic programmes should meet the regional requirements, national aspirations and should be at par with the world class standards. Further, the University should make an assessment of the existing academic programmes as may be available in the adjoining Universities so as to avoid gaps and duplications.
- (iv) Teachers-students ratio shall be adhered to over a period of time in accordance with the norms framed by various regulatory bodies and the UGC from time to time i.e. for PG Programme (Science Programme-1:10), (Humanities/ Social Sciences-1:15), (Commerce & Management 1:15), (Media & Mass Communication-1:10) and for UG Programme (Social Sciences-1:30), (Sciences-1:25), (B.Ed. / B.El.D-As per NCTE norms), (Media & Mass Communication-1:15).
- (v) The Universities may follow the guidelines issued by the Department of Expenditure which envisages that the teaching and non-teaching staff ratio should be not higher than 1:1.1.
- (vi) The nomenclature of the degree(s) should be as specified by the UGC. However, if the universities wish to introduce any other programmes, which is not as specified by the UGC, it may send a detailed proposal to the UGC for its consideration and approval.
- (vii) The Universities should follow the UGC Regulations as issued from time to time.
