
The agenda of the BOS meeting (via email circulation) was as follows:

Broad Objectives of the Course:

- The Diploma Program in and MA Hindu Studies (for External Candidates) is targeted towards people who wish to develop deeper expertise in a specific area of Hindu culture, thought, philosophy and tradition without pursuing a degree.
- The course provides broad survey of Hinduism or Sanatan Dharma and different religious systems and sub-systems attached to it. It also intends to acquaint the learners and seekers alike with the primary doctrinal corpus in the form of literature as well as oral folk traditions.
- This course is in no way meant to impart theological training to the pursuant but in a sublime manner intends to explain dominant Hindu beliefs and values and encourages one to consider the importance of these ideas to the modern life.
- ❖ In the identity ridden world, this course, in a preliminary sense, is meant to make the learner understand what comprises Hindu identity, in historical as well as contemporary sense.
- Some diploma course credits may be transferable towards a Degree program at a later stage.

Eligibility Conditions: A bachelor's degree in any discipline from a university/college established by a law in India including Shastri;

Or

Degree of a foreign university which may be recognized equivalent for the purpose by the Vice Chancellor.

- a. The duration of the Diploma is One Year and for the MA is two years based on the annual system of examination. The exams will be held in accordance to the schedule prescribed by the University from time to time or in accordance with the university academic calendar. Bachelor/UG Degree of a recognized University or an equivalent examination in any discipline.
- b. Those who have successfully completed the P.G. Diploma in Hindu Studies are eligible for registration for MA Hindu Studies second year as lateral entry.

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Core Compulsory/Open Courses - 40 Credits:

The full course of PG Diploma in Hindu Studies and MA in Hindu Studies First Year (for external candidates) shall comprise of 05 papers mentioned as under: -

- 1. Understanding Hinduism: Its Panth, Matt, Sampraday, Philosophy and Traditions
- 2. Ramayana
- 3. Mahabharata
- 4. Guru Granth Sahib
- 5. Project Paper

The medium of instruction shall be English, Hindi and Sanskrit.

Credits Equivalent and Marks:

PG Diploma in Hindu Studies: 40 Credits

There are five papers having a total of 40 credits having 08 credits for each paper (One credit is equivalent to 20 hours of lectures / organized classroom activity / contact hours; 10 hours of practical / field /Tutorial / teacher-led activity and 30 hours of other workload such as independent individual /group work; obligatory / optional work placement; literature survey / library work; data collection / field work; writing of papers / projects / dissertation; seminars, etc.). The minimum marks required to pass the examination shall be 40% in each paper.

MA in Hindu Studies: 80 Credits

A student has to choose five courses in a year and each course is of 8 Credits making it a total of 80 credit course. The minimum marks required to pass the examination shall be 40 % in each paper.

© Note: For the completion of the Master Programme (two years), students have to choose 10 core compulsory/open courses totalling 80 credits.

Attendance Requirements: Students are expected to attend all the lectures diligently in order to be able to benefit fully from the course. A minimum of 75% attendance is a must failing which a student may not be permitted to appear in the examination for PG Diploma in Hindu Studies.




