4. Thereafter, the Vice-Chancellor invited Registrar for further proceedings. The Registrar extended warm welcome to all the members of the Academic Council of the University and thereafter invited Vice-Chancellor to present his address.



5. The Vice-Chancellor Prof. S.P. Bansal welcomed the distinguished members of the Academic Council. The Vice-Chancellor informed the Academic Council that Central University of Himachal Pradesh, Dharamshala has been recently accredited by NAAC with A+ grade with CPGA of 3.42 and has become the first institute of the State of Himachal Pradesh to be Accredited with A+ Grade. He remarked this achievement of the University as historical in itself and a great achievement for Central University of Himachal Pradesh. All the Academic Council members congratulated the Vice-Chancellor for this notable achievement of the University and remarked that the whole credit for this goes to all the members of the University who worked hard under the leadership of its dynamic Vice-Chancellor. The Academic Council remarked this achievement of the University as a significant milestone in its journey and conveyed best wishes for the future. All the Academic Council members praised the efforts made by the Vice-Chancellor and all the University employees to achieve this goal. The Academic Council members remarked that despite being in its infancy, the university has achieved a milestone which is a dream for many of the long established Universities and Institutes. The Academic Council Members appreciated the contribution of Vice-Chancellor for his efforts and precious guidance for achieving this goal. The Academic Council was of strong opinion that the attainment of A+ grade from NAAC has become possible only due to dynamic leadership of the Vice-Chancellor.

The Vice-Chancellor further appraised the Academic Council that the implementation of recommendations of National Education Policy-2020 has contributed a lot for getting higher Accreditation status from NAAC. The Vice-Chancellor further appraised the Academic Council that in future, the Central University of Himachal Pradesh will emphasize on Research and Development. More rigorous efforts will be made by the University in future for Internationalization of various University affairs. The University will launch ten Online courses from January-2024 onwards for which necessary formalities will be carried out with Distance Education Bureau (DEB), UGC. The Academic Council accorded its approval to start ten online courses by the University from January-2024 onwards. The Academic Council approved to initiate the necessary formalities for starting online programmes from DEB. The Vice-Chancellor further informed about various academic initiatives by the University which have recently been started and which mainly included new degree, diploma, certificate courses, adoption of various guidelines of UGC including NHEQF and updation of course curriculum having ingredient of Human Values and Life Skills.

The Vice-Chancellor also appraised the Academic Council about the admission status in various programmes of the University through CUET and the admission made by the University through its own efforts. The Academic Council applauded the efforts of the University for increasing the admission status.

6. Thereafter, the Vice-Chancellor invited Prof. Vishal Sood, Registrar-cum-Ex Officio Secretary to take up the agenda items as follows:





**Item No. 35.1: To place before the Academic Council the matter regarding repealment of Ordinance No. 24: Cadre Recruitment Rules including manner of appointment, other service conditions and emoluments of employees other than teachers and other academic staff.**

It is submitted before the Academic Council that the university had advertised various Non-Teaching positions vide Employment Notice No. 001/2023 dated 03.02.2023 as per CRR circulated by the UGC. In the meanwhile the Executive Council of the university vide item No. 59.8 in its 59th meeting held on 15.02.2023, showed the concerns regarding age stipulated in the advertisement (No. 001/2023 dated 03.02.2023) and forwarded its suggestions for incorporating in the advertisement. After detailed discussion in the matter, the Executive Council unanimously approved that the Employment Notice No. 001/2023 dated 03.02.2023 be withdrawn immediately and the matter of CRR related to Non-Teaching cadre be re-examined as per concern/suggestion of Executive Council.

In pursuance to above decision of the Executive Council, the university withdrew the advertisement for various Non-Teaching positions advertised vide Employment Notice No. 001/2023 dated 03.02.2023 and the Existing CRR (as per Model CRR of UGC) were again forwarded to the Committee constituted by the university vide officer order No. 1-4/CUHP/Rectt./2010/Vol.V/5713-14 dated 11.10.2022 to re-examine the Model CRRs of UGC and submit its recommendations.

The meeting of the committee (constituted to frame the CRR) was convened on 24.02.2023 and the committee framed CRR for recruitment of various Non-Teaching positions of the university. It is further apprised that as per above suggestions of the Executive Council, the committee made minor changes w.r.t. to age condition for various Non-Teaching positions.

The CRR so framed by the committee were forwarded to the Ministry of Education, Government of India vide letter No. 1-4/CUHP/ Rectt./Vol.VI/1771 dated 01.03.2023 and subsequent reminders dated 31.03.2023, 18.07.2023 for further approval so that the university could initiate further action to fill vacant Non-Teaching positions under Mission Mode Recruitment of Government of India at the earliest in a time bound manner. The Ministry of Education vide letter F. No. 54-3/2023-CU.III dated 21<sup>st</sup> September, 2023 conveyed the University to frame CRR in accordance with the Model CRR and submit it to the Ministry as part of an Ordinance for assent of Hon'ble Visitor. However, the University has adopted the Model CRRs (as circulated by the UGC) vide Notification F.No.3-3/CUHP/GA/2010/Vol. IV/5662-76 dated 21<sup>st</sup> September, 2023 in toto as per approval accorded by Executive Council in its 63<sup>rd</sup> vide Item No. 63.10(meeting held on 11<sup>th</sup> September, 2023).

Apart from this, it is appraised to the Academic Council that there are vacant positions of Medical Officer, Pharmacist, Medical Attendant/Dresser in the University for which the UGC has not circulated any CRRs. In this regard, the



UGC vide its letter F.No. 7-1/2022(JCRC) dated 27<sup>th</sup> September, 2022 has clearly mentioned that *in case, the Model CRRs of any specific post existing/sanctioned in any university is not covered in these rules, the University may refer the proposed CRRs of such post to the UGC for approval.* Keeping in view these guidelines of UGC, the CRRs for above three posts (for which no Model CRRs have been circulated by UGC), the University Committee constituted vide Office Order F.No. 1-4/CUHP/ Rectt./Vol.VI/1771 dated 01.03.2023 has framed CRRs for these posts which are placed at **Annexure-35.1(A)** for consideration/approval and further recommending to the Executive Council for its adoption/implementation in the University. It is pertinent to mention here that CRRs for above three posts shall be made a part of University Ordinance No. 24 only after receipt of its approval from UGC and thereafter shall be implemented in the University as per the directions of the UGC vide letter F.No. F.No. 7-1/2022(JCRC) dated 27<sup>th</sup> September, 2022.

**The Academic Council deliberated the issue at length and accorded its approval to adopt Model CRRs (as circulated by University Grants Commission) and also approved Ordinance No. 24 prepared on the basis of these CRRs for recruitment/ appointment / promotion of various Non-Teaching positions in the University. The Academic Council also recommended to implement the newly framed Ordinance 24 in the university immediately after approval of Executive Council.**

**Further, the Academic Council unanimously decided to change the age in following manner for the post of Medical Officer, Pharmacist and Medical Attendant/Dresser (as recommended by the committee constituted vide Office Order F.No. 1-4/CUHP/ Rectt./Vol.VI/1771 dated 01.03.2023) for which no Model CRRs have been circulated by UGC. The Academic Council decided to fix the respective age as per Model CRRs of UGC for respective cadres:**

- i. **The maximum age for the post of Medical Officer(Allopathic/Ayurveda) be fixed as 40 years as in case of Group A cadre posts in Model CRRs,**
- ii. **The maximum age for the post of Pharmacist and Medical Attendant/Dresser be fixed as 32 years as in case of Group B cadre posts in Model CRRs.**

**The Academic Council further approved that the test for recruitment/appointment of various Non-Teaching positions under Group B & C posts shall be conducted through National Testing Agency (NTA). The Academic Council further recommended and approved that the syllabus/Scheme of examination for various Non-Teaching positions under Group B & C shall be the same as developed/prescribed by NTA. The Academic Council recommended to repeal the decision of**

Executive Council in this context specifically (Refer 2<sup>nd</sup> Sentence of 2<sup>1</sup> Para of Executive Council decision of its 63<sup>rd</sup> Meeting held on 11.09.2023 vide Item No. 63.10).

The Academic Council also recommended and approved that the recruitment / appointment / Promotions to various Group A posts be made by University as per Model CRRs adopted by the university. The Academic Council further recommended and approved that promotions to various non-teaching positions under Group B & Group C Cadre be made by the University as per Model CRRs adopted by the university.

The Academic Council recommended that entire above recommendations / approval be placed in Executive Council for approval and framing of new Ordinance No. 24, accordingly.

**Item No. 35.1(S): To place the matter regarding approval for the change of specialization/programme of BFA (Painting) and BFA (Sculpture) programme in 3<sup>rd</sup> Semester batch 2020 to 2024, batch 2021 to 2025 and batch 2022 to 2026.**

Students who were admitted in BFA (Sculpture) and BFA(Painting) programmes in session 2020, 2021 & 2022 changed their course to BFA (Painting) and BFA (Sculpture) in their respective 3<sup>rd</sup> Semester respectively as the syllabus of Painting & Sculpture in first two semesters is same. These students are presently in 7<sup>th</sup> Semester, 5<sup>th</sup> Semester & 3<sup>rd</sup> Semester respectively. The above matter related to change of specialization/programme of concerned students of respective batches was submitted by Head of Department of Visual Arts to Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor who has further directed to place the entire matter in the meeting of Academic Council for decision/further directions in this regard.

Therefore the above matter is placed before the Academic Council for further decision/directions regarding change of specialization / programme as well as declaration of examination result accordingly.

**The Academic Council deliberated the issue at length and accorded its approval to change specialization/ programme of BFA (Painting) to BFA (Sculpture) and BFA (Sculpture) to BFA (Painting) Programme of the concerned students of respective batches of 2020 to 2024, batch 2021 to 2025 and batch 2022 to 2026. The Academic Council also accorded its approval to declare the examination result of such students as per changed specialization / programme (approved as above).**

**It was also approved by the Academic Council that the decision / approval be placed in the Executive Council meeting for final approval.**

**Item No.35.2(S): To place the matter regarding course EEL-110 "Functional and Communication Skills in English" of BFA (Both Painting & Sculpture) Batch 2019 to 2023 and 2020 to 2024 and its examination result.**

It is appraised to the Academic Council that during Covid-19 period the students of BFA programme of (Both Painting & Sculpture) of batch 2019 and 2020 have attended online classes in course EEL-110. These online classes were taken by Guest Faculty of Department of English at that time and concerned Guest Faculty has detained the students of both batches (expect 5 students) on account of short attendance in online classes in this course. The students were not intimated regarding this detention and they were not allowed to appear in examination. Thereafter, in the year 2023, the Head of the department of visual arts



conducted the examination in the concerned course by taking support of Department of English. However, the Head of the Department of visual arts has not sought the permission of University authorities to conduct this examination. Now the Head of the department of visual arts has requested to regularize this exam conducted in 2023 in course EEL-10 and declare students result accordingly. The above matter is submitted by 'Head of the department of Visual Arts to the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor who has further directed to place the entire matter in the meeting of Academic Council for decision/further directions in this regard.

Therefore, the above matter is placed before the Academic Council to make decision on the following points:-

- i. The Exam conducted by department of Visual Arts in 2023 in course EEL-110 be accorded permission and regularized accordingly.
- ii. The result in course EEL-110 in the exam conducted in 2023 be declared.
- iii. Permission be accorded to change the course credits of EEL-110 from 4 Credit to 2 Credit exclusively for the exam conducted by department of Visual Art in year 2023.
- iv. The dues from the students as per University norms, if any pending on account of this exam in EEL-110 be allowed to be charged from the respective students.

**The Academic Council deliberated the issue at length and accorded its approval as follows:**

- i. **The Exam conducted by department of Visual Arts in 2023 in course EEL-110 is accorded permission and regularized by Academic Council.**
- ii. **The Academic Council approved to declare the result in course EEL-110 in the exam conducted in 2023.**
- iii. **Permission is accorded by the Academic Council to change the course credits of EEL-110 from 4 Credit to 2 Credit exclusively for the exam conducted by department of Visual Art in year 2023.**
- iv. **The Academic Council approved to charge the dues from the students, if any pending on account of this exam in EEL-110 from the respective students as per University norms.**



Studies in the year 2022. The Academic Council also approved that this research scholar be provided with UGC JRF/SRF from the respective date as per UGC / University Rules.


It was also approved by the Academic Council that the decision / approval be placed in the Executive Council meeting for final approval.
