The Centre for Entrepreneurship and Innovation, School of Commerce and Management Studies, Central University of Himachal Pradesh organised a "Business Plan Competition" on 13 March, 2019 from 10:00 am onward in Seminar Hall, Dhauladhar Parisar-II.

The competition was organised in collaboration with the Entrepreneurial Club of the HPKV Business School. In total, 11 teams from the five different departments with their business plan participated in this competition.



The business plans presented by the students were Meals on Wheels, Way to Home, Sanjivni, Trek on Tech, ARCHIT, SmartSolutions, CareTech, HikersBand, Eco-Save, KhairKhabar, and Himalayan Cab.

Dr. Hem Raj Bansal, Dr. Harsh Mishra, and Dr. Chaman Kashyap were the judges of this competition. The presented business plans were evaluated on five criteria; feasibility, profitability, social relevance, the content of the plan and presentation. Business plan of Sanjivni won the first prize while KhairKhabar and Trek on Tech won the second and third prize.
