ITEM(S) FOR RATIFICATION:

Item No. 27.3: To place before the Academic Council the matter regarding amendment/replace/repeal of Ordinance No. 1 in consonance with approved Statute 40.

The Ministry of Human Resource Development vide letter F.No. 54-1/2016-CU.III dated 26th February, 2019 has conveyed the approval of the Visitor His Excellency the President of India on proposed amendment in Statute 40 of the University dealing with establishment of Schools, Departments and Centre of Studies. The 1st amendment in Statute 40 of the University was published in Part-III, Section 4 of The Gazette of India vide Regd. No. D.L.-33004/99 dated 26th February, 2019.

Accordingly, Ordinance No. 1: deals with establishment of Schools, Departments and Centre of Studies has been reframed in consonance with notified Statute 40.

The Academic Council noted, ratified and further recommended to the Executive Council for its approval.

Item No. 27.4: To place before the Academic Council the matter regarding adoption of the University Grants Commission (Redress of Grievances of Students), Regulations 2019.

The University Grants Commission vide Notification F.No. 14-4/2012(CPP-II) dated 06th May, 2019 notified the University Grants Commission (Redress of Grievances of Students), Regulations, 2019 to provide a redress of certain grievances of students already enrolled in any institution, as well as those seeking admission to such institutions, and a mechanism thereto is required to be adopted in the University for the welfare of the students, placed as per **ANNEXURE-27.4[A]**. In pursuance to the Notification, the Vice-Chancellor under powers vested in him under section 11(3) of Central Universities Act, 2009 constituted the Committees as per Clause 5(B) & (C) of University Grants

Commission (Redress of Students) Regulations, 2019. The University notified the Committees of Institutional Student Grievance Redressal Committee and Departmental Student Grievance Redressal Committee for the redress of grievances of the University Students vide Notification F.No. 1-4/हि.प्र.के.वि./ शै./ 2010/खंड-II/5265-70 दिनांक 01 सितम्बर, 2020 and 1-4/हि.प्र.के.वि./ शै./2010/खंड-II/5259-64 दिनांक 01 सितम्बर, 2020 respectively.

The Academic Council noted, ratified and further recommended to the Executive Council for its approval.

Item No. 27.5: To place before the Academic Council the matter regarding adoption of the UGC Regulations on Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and Other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education, 2018.

The University Grants Commission vide Notification No. F. 1-2/ 2017(EC/PS) dated 18th July, 2018 has stated that the UGC with the concurrence of the Government of India MHRD has framed the UGC Regulations on Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and Other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education, 2018. The University has already adopted these regulations for appointment of Teachers and other Academic Staff by the Orders of the Vice-Chancellor under powers vested in him under section 11(3) of Central Universities Act, 2009 vide notification F.No. 1-3/हि.प्र.के.वि./ भर्ती/2010/खंड-VI/3614-20 दिनांक 02 अगस्त, 2018 [ANNEXURE-27.5(B)].

The Academic Council noted, ratified and further recommended to the Executive Council for its approval.

Item No. 27.6

To place before the Academic Council the matter regarding implementation of two credit course of Research and Publication Ethics(RPE) for all Ph.D. students from the Academic Session 2020-21.

The University Grants Commission vide D.O. letter F.No. 1-1/2018(Journal/CARE) dated December, 2019 has directed that

two Credit Courses for awareness about publication ethics and publication misconducts entitled "Research and Publication Ethics(RPE)" to be made compulsory for all Ph.D. students for pre-registration course work in the forthcoming academic session i.e. 2020-21.

The University has adopted the above two "Research and Publication Ethics(RPE)" course by the Orders of the Vice-Chancellor under powers vested in him under section 11(3) of Central Universities Act, 2009 vide notification F.No. 1-10/हि.प्र.के.वि./शै./ 2014/5100-08 दिनांक 25 अगस्त, 2020 [ANNEXURE-27.6(A)].

The Academic Council noted, ratified and further recommended to the Executive Council for its approval.

ITEM(S) FOR CONSIDERATION AND DECISION:

Item No. 27.7 To place before the Academic Council the matter regarding recommendations submitted by the Committee on Veda-Bhushan & Veda Vibhushan three years Degree.

Maharshi Sandipani Rashtriya Vedavidya Pratishthan, Vedavidya Marg, Chintaman Ganesh, PO Jawasiya, Ujjain-456006(MP) vide letter F.No. 1-8/2007(A&F)/MSRVVP/Recognitions/ dated 25th June, 2020 has forwarded proposal regarding entry qualifications for B.A.(Sanskrit)/B.A.(Arts) alongwith complete syllabus of Veda Bhushan & Veda Vibhushan courses of MSRVVP. A committee vide Notification F. No. 1-1/हि.प्र.के.वि./शै./2010/खंड-VI/3810-17 dated 03 July, 2020 was constituted by the Vice-Chancellor for the perusal and recommendations on the said proposal. The following recommendations are submitted by the committee vide email dated 23rd July, 2020 ANNEXURE-27.7[A]:

- i. द्विवर्षीय वेद विभूषण +2 कला संकाय (Arts Group) के समकक्ष है।
- ii. द्विवर्षीय वेद विभूषण उपाधि प्राप्त छात्र हिमाचल प्रदेश केन्द्रीय विश्वविद्यालय, धर्मशाला के द्वारा संचालित स्नातक स्तर के सभी पाठ्यक्रमों में (विज्ञान संकाय के पाठ्यक्रमों को छोड़कर) प्रवेश के योग्य हैं।
- iii. अतः विश्वविद्यालय प्रवेश नियमों के आधीन अर्हताओं को पूर्ण करते हुए द्विवर्षीय वेद विभूषण उपाधि प्राप्त छात्र हिमाचल प्रदेश केन्द्रीय

विश्वविद्यालय, धर्मशाला के द्वारा संचालित स्नातक स्तर के सभी पाठ्यक्रमों में (विज्ञान संकाय के पाठ्यक्रमों को छोड़कर) दिया जा सकता है।

The Academic Council considered the recommendations of the Committee and approved two year Veda-Vibhushan Degree as eligibility criteria for seeking admission in BA(Sanskrit)/BA courses besides other minimum eligibility criterion as envisaged in CUHP Rules/Ordinances and recommended for approval of the Executive Council.

Item No. 27.8:

To place before the Academic Council the matter regarding setting up of the Department of Disabilities studies in Central/State Universities with a view to creating pool of academician and rehabilitation of professionals.

Recommendations in Annual Report of Office of Chief Commissioner for Persons with Disabilities (CCPwDs) for the year 2016-17 & 2017-18 has been forwarded by the University Grants Commission vide letter F. No. 6-2/2016(ST) dated 12th June, 2020. The following recommendations pertaining to the University are as follows:-

Annual Report 2016-17:

- i. Setting up of the Department of Disabilities Studies in Central/State Universities with a view to creating pool of academician and rehabilitation of professional.
- ii. Separate sitting arrangement for Divyangjan on ground floor only with accessible approach in the all competitive examination by UPSC/SSC/CBSC and other academic programmes for Engineering and professional courses.

Annual Report 2017-18:

- iii. Website accessibility should be strengthened expedited.

The University Grants Commission has also requested to furnish the pointwise Action Taken Report.

The Academic Council deliberated on the recommendations in Annual Report of Office of the Chief Commissioner for Persons with Disabilities (CCPwDs) and has accorded its 'In-principle'

approval for setting up of the Department of Disabilities Studies in the University and also recommended to strengthen the website accessibility to Divyangjan.

The Chairman also apprised the members that the Department of Disabilities Studies should be opened in the University for the welfare of Persons with Disabilities.

ITEM NO. 27.9: To place before the Academic Council the matter regarding issuance of Certificates/Detailed Marks Card in bilingual basis.

The University Grants Commission vide letter F.No. 16-1/2020 (राजभाषा) dated 01st June, 2020[ANNEXURE-27.9(A)] has directed the University to issue the Certificates/Detail Marks Card of Undergraduate/ Post-Graduate students in bilingual (English & Regional/Hindi) languages who passed/qualified their respective Programmes of Study in the University and action taken be initiated.

The Academic Council deliberated on the directions of the University Grants Commission and approve to adopt bilingual(English/Hindi) languages for issuance of certificates/ Detail Marks Card and further recommended to the Executive Council for its approval.

ITEM NO: 27.10: To place before the Academic Council the Annual Report 2019-20 of the University for the period from 1st April, 2019 to 31st March, 2020.

The Central Universities Act, 2009 under section 30 provides that the "Annual Report" of the University shall be prepared under the direction of the Executive Council, which shall include, among other matters, the steps taken by the University towards the fulfillment of its objects and shall be submitted to the Court on or before such dates as may be prescribed by the Statutes and the Court shall consider the report in its annual meeting. The Court shall submit the annual report to the Visitor along with its comments, if any and a copy of the Annual Report, as prepared shall also be submitted to the Central Government, which shall as

soon as may be, cause the same to be laid before both the Houses of Parliament.

The Annual Report for the period 1st April, 2019 to 31st March, 2020[ANNEXURE-27.10(A)] is approved by the Academic Council and further recommended to the Executive Council for its approval.

The Chairman of the Committee also apprised the members that PG Diploma in Jammu & Kashmir Studies has been started in Sharda Script and also recommended that the 10+2 Pass candidate shall be eligible for admission in place of 10+2 with 50% marks.

Item No. 27.13: To place before the Academic Council the matter regarding approval of following Memorandum of Understanding(s) (MoU):

A proposal from the Dean, School of Life Sciences and Dean, Earth & Environmental Sciences has been received for research and academic collaboration with different institutions. The Academic Council approved the above mentioned MoU(s) and further recommended to the Executive Council for its approval.

Item No.27.1(T): To place before the Academic Council the matter regarding fee to be charged for the verification of Degree/Certificates conferred by Central University of Himachal Pradesh.

The Central University of Himachal Pradesh has entered into an agreement with CDSL Ventures Limited, Mumbai (Digital Depository authorized by the Ministry of Human Resource Development) for lodging its academic awards in National Academic Depository (NAD) on 22.04.2017. The CDSL Ventures Limited vide email dated 5th February, 2018 has requested the University to intimate the charges for verification of Degree/Certificates conferred by Central University of Himachal Pradesh.

The University has also received various requests for verification of Degree/Certificate from India & abroad from the employers/Head of the Institutes, Embassy or High Commission and Indian Credentials Verification Agencies. In view of the above, the Vice-Chancellor constituted a Committee vide Notification No. 7-1/CUHP/GA/2015/ 5044-47 dated 05.10.2028

to propose a fee structure for the verification of Degree/Certificates conferred by the University. The Chairman of the Committee submitted the report vide Letter F.No. PVC/1-1/CUHP/2018/1802 dated 11.10.2018 [ANNEXURE-27.1(T)]. The recommendations of the Committee are as under:-

1. The request of the verification of Degree/Certificates conferred by CUHP shall be done on the basis of formal request made by the concerned office on a prescribed pro-forma developed by the University.
2. The request for Degree/Certificate verification should be addressed to the office of the Controller of Examinations, CUHP.
3. The fee for the verification of Degree/Certificate shall be as follow:-
 - a. INR 1500 per degree certification for verification request from India.
 - b. INR 5000 per degree certificate for verification request from abroad.
4. The fee for verification of Degree/Certificate is to be remitted through NEFT, NET Banking, Debit Card to the Finance Officer on the account details given in the Pro-forma.

The Academic Council deliberated on the recommendations submitted by the Chairman and unanimously approved the fee for the verification of Degree/Certificate as follow:

- (i). INR 1500 per degree certification for verification request from India.
- (ii). INR 10,000 per degree certification for verification request from abroad.

The Academic Council also approved the proforma for formal request for verification of Degree/Certificate.

In the last, the Chairman apprised the members that Central University of Himachal Pradesh shall constitute 'हिमालयी इतिहास परिषद' under the Department of History. The modalities for the constitution of हिमालयी इतिहास परिषद shall be as under:

1. इस परिषद में हिमालयी क्षेत्र में स्थित सभी विश्वविद्यालयों एवं महाविद्यालयों के इतिहास के अध्यापक सदस्य बन सकेंगे।

2. सदस्य बनने के लिए निर्धारित प्रपत्र पर आवेदन करना पड़ेगा लेकिन सदस्यता निशुल्क होगी।
3. हिमाचल प्रदेश केन्द्रीय विश्वविद्यालय का इतिहास विभाग प्रति वर्ष या दो वर्ष के अन्तराल के बाद हिमालयी इतिहास कांग्रेस का आयोजन किया करेगा।
4. आयोजन हेतु समाज विज्ञान स्कूल के अधिष्ठाता कांग्रेस के संरक्षक रहेंगे और इतिहास विभाग के विभागाध्यक्ष संयोजक तथा अध्यापक आयोजक सदस्य रहेंगे।

The Academic Council considered the proposal and approved the constitution of हिमालयी इतिहास परिषद and also approved Membership Format and further recommended to the Executive Council for its approval.

The Chairman apprised the members that University has appointed newly faculty in different departments. As per the condition of the appointment letter these teachers were on probation for a period of one year from the date of their joining in this University. For confirmation in the University a work and conduct report of the teacher is necessary. Therefore, to report the work and conduct, a channel could be prescribed. So the Academic Council members unanimously approved the following hierarchy:
